### Fire Hall Break-in and Theft - UPDATE

**Bonnyville, AB., April 10, 2025** – At 0122 hours this morning the Bonnyville Regional Fire Authority (BRFA) was notified by our alarm monitoring service that an unauthorized entry was made into our Iron River (Station 4) Fire Hall. RCMP were immediately notified and upon arrival of BRFA members it was obvious that a fire truck, R40, had been stolen from the building. Surveillance camera footage is currently being reviewed to assist in the investigation.

**UPDATE** – As of 0900 hours this morning, this vehicle has been located thanks to a report from a member of the public. It is currently being recovered and moved to a secure facility for further investigation and inspection.

The BRFA is relocating firefighting resources to ensure ongoing protection for the Iron River area and the MD of Bonnyville.
